# Scope of Clinical Psychology

- According to the widely accepted standards, Clinical psychology is
- A science-based profession that integrates theory and clinical practice to understand, prevent, and relieve psychological problems or disorders whether they are mild, moderate, severe, chronic, or complex. (ACPA, <a href="https://acpa.org.au/Web/Web/CP/What-is-a-Clinical-Psychologist.aspx">https://acpa.org.au/Web/Web/CP/What-is-a-Clinical-Psychologist.aspx</a>).
- A field of practice that deals with human functioning; either human problems and their solution, as well as with the promotion of physical, mental, and social well-being. (CPA, <a href="https://cpa.ca/sections/clinicalpsychology/">https://cpa.ca/sections/clinicalpsychology/</a>).
- The psychological specialty that provides continuing and comprehensive mental and behavioral health care for individuals and families; consultation to agencies and communities; training, education and supervision; and research-based practice. It is a specialty in breadth one that is broadly inclusive of severe psychopathology and marked by comprehensiveness and integration of knowledge and skill from a broad array of disciplines within and outside of psychology proper.
- The scope of clinical psychology encompasses all ages, multiple diversities and varied systems (APA, <a href="https://www.apa.org/ed/graduate/specialize/clinical">https://www.apa.org/ed/graduate/specialize/clinical</a>)

# Four Procedures for Clinical psychologists

Clinical psychologists are expected to be able to follow these four procedures specific to their specialty:

- Assessment (diagnostic interviewing, behavioral assessment, administration and interpretation of psychological test measures)
- Intervention (primary, secondary and tertiary levels): clinical services to individuals, families and groups.)
- Consultation (inter- and intra-professional practice with other health and behavioral health professionals and organizations)
- Research (engagement with specific research and critical review of science, knowledge and methods pertaining to clinical psychology) (APA, <a href="https://www.apa.org/ed/graduate/specialize/clinical">https://www.apa.org/ed/graduate/specialize/clinical</a>).

#### Competencies

Graduates of Master of Clinical Psychology Program are expected to be competent at;

- Knowledge on psychopathology, diagnosis, identification and intervention.
- Knowledge on lifelong psychological health and disorders which depends on solid knowledge on psychopathology.
- Knowledge on and skills related to application of psychological tests, grading, reporting and integrating and synthesizing their results with other personality tests.
- Knowledge on and skills related to cooperation with other mental health professionals and institutions, consultation and guidance in cases of severe mental disorders.
- Knowledge on and skills related to conducting research and critical thinking and evaluation about scientific research in clinical psychology.

#### Duration of study

- Three semesters,
- 5 compulsory courses
- 5 elective courses
- Graduation Research Project
- Field practice and supervision, 1 semester, 35 hours a week (30 hours field practice and 5 hours supervision), supervised clinical practice at a department approved institution.

# Professional Training


Students in clinical psychology master program enroll the courses; PSY505 Field Practice and PSY535 Supervision I and PSY506 Field Practice and PSY536 Supervision II which include internship practices as 35 hours (3 and a half work day in a week under the supervision of a clinical psychologist at an institution approved by Psychology Department at Atılım University, based on the following criteria:

- integrating theoretical knowledge with practice,
- learning psychological methods,
- working under supervision,
- being able to discuss and interpret human behavior,
- finding the opportunity to work with other colleagues.

# Professional Training

At the end of the courses; PSY505 Field Practice and PSY535 Supervision I and PSY506 Field Practice and PSY 536 Supervision II, the institution in which the students complete their internship period, *«intern psychologist observation and development report»* is prepared for each student. The report includes;

- professional activities that the student participated in,
- clinical psychology applications the student participated in,
- clinical interviews with clients or applicants,
- tests and the other assessment measures that the student applied,
- the scope and the duration of the supervision that the student obtained.

#### Admission requirements

#### **Candidates**


- Must have a BS/BA degree in Psychology (Formal Education four-year undergraduate program). Applicants who are graduated from universities abroad must have an equivalence certificate to be obtained from the Council of Higher Education.
- A minimum undergraduate graduation grade point average of 2.70 over 4
- 60 points from the ALES Equal Weighted Score type. (Graduate Record Examination (GRE) for international applicants)
- English Language proficiency (YDS 80, YÖKDİL 80, TOEFL IBT 96)
- 70 points out of 100 from the written exam
- 70 points out of 100 from the interview

#### Admission requirements

- Applicants who score 75 and above in the total evaluation with the department's Academic Committee Suggestion and the Institute Board of Directors' decision, are ranked by considering the following criteria;
- 50% of ALES score (GRE-converted score)\*
- 15% of the English language score,
- 15% of the undergraduate GPA,
- 10% of the written science exam score
- 10% of the interview score
- \*GRE scores will be converted to 0-100 scale.
